As part of recovery efforts to address the damages caused by Hurricane Maria, the Catholic Church applied for and was awarded funding from FEMA's Public Assistance program ("FEMA PA") to help finance the restoration and protection of approximately 490 Church-owned facilities across Puerto Rico. The Archdiocese of San Juan, and the Dioceses of Arecibo, Caguas, and Fajardo-Humacao (each, a "Church Entity") entered into separate agreements with Puerto Rico's Central Office of Recovery, Reconstruction and Resiliency which define the terms and conditions under which each Church Entity will use the Federal Assistance awarded by FEMA in connection with FEMA Disasters EM-3384 and DR-4339.

The Church Entities (separately identified above) are issuing this Request for Proposals ("RFP") to solicit competitive proposals from qualified firms or entities interested in providing construction management services in connection with the design, permitting, and construction phases of the repair, reconstruction, and new construction of the damaged facilities. Each Church Entity intends to enter into a separate construction management services agreement with the selected Respondent(s).

The RFP describes the services being procured and the criteria that the Church Entities will use to evaluate each Proposal. Responses to this RFP must comply with the instructions set forth in the RFP documents. Proposals will be held in confidence and will not be released for public review until final award of the agreements. This RFP is designed to promote fair and open competition and to comply with the provisions of 2 C.F.R. 200 and other applicable regulations.

The non-mandatory pre-submission conference will be held <u>at the time and date</u> indicated above and will be open to the public. Respondents are encouraged to attend.

Proposals may be submitted via electronic mail or in hard copy at the address specified in the RFP.
